Ernst Terpstra, the author of the article '*Is Easter a Cosmic Festival?*' (in the March-May 2019 issue of 'Perspectives', the quarterly magazine of The Christian Community) asked for the following correction. In the article he claimed that the duration of the 100% full moon phase is more than 24 hours; however, it turned out that this is not true. What has been attributed to the 100% phase is actually the period in which more than 99.5% of the moon surface is illuminated by the sun. The much shorter duration of the 100% phase is about 2 hours for a non-moving observer.
